# Chromebook Care and Responsibility

- Every student at Lexington Middle School will be issued a Chromebook at the beginning of the year.
- These are incredible tools for learning and collaborating with other students inside and outside the classroom.
- Each student has the responsibility to take care of the Chromebook and make sure it is charged for class each day.

# Contact 101

- Email is the best method of contact for teachers. We are busy 90% of the day teaching, but will get back to you during planning, before school, or after school.
- You may get emails, texts, or phone calls from **School Messenger**. Be careful, they might sound robotic, but often have important information about school safety, schoolwide events, or weather.
- Check your student's grades often throughout the quarter. If they are struggling it is easier to help them at the beginning, rather than trying to make up several assignments right at the end.

- Teachers might also use Google Voice numbers to call or text. These numbers will be listed in the Google Classroom if teachers use this tool.
